**Fr Scott Says:** Sanctifying time has always been a practice of the Catholic Church. This is seen first in the Liturgy of the Hours, the official prayer of the Church that the consecrated and ordained pray throughout the day. It can also be seen by the different daily and monthly devotions that have come about through time. For example, every day of the week has a particular devotion attached to it. That means every day has a specific mystery or saint for us to contemplate through the day. Sundays are devoted to contemplating the Resurrection and the Holy Trinity. Monday's devotion is the Holy Spirit and praying for the poor souls of Purgatory. Tuesdays are devoted to the holy angels who guide and protect us. Wednesdays are devoted to St Joseph, the model husband and worker. Thursdays are devoted to contemplating the real presence of Jesus in the Holy Eucharist. Then on Fridays we contemplate the Sacred Heart of Jesus and His Passion. Finally, Saturdays are Mary's day as she prepares us to again celebrate the Resurrection on Sunday. Every month has a particular devotion, too. Throughout this month of July contemplate our Lord's Precious Blood, which He poured out on the Cross for your salvation. Give Him thanks for it and pray we can all show proper reverence for His Precious Blood in the Holy Eucharist.
