Fr Scott Says: This Friday (the 14th) is the Memorial of St Kateri Tekakwitha. St Kateri was the first canonized Native American. She was born in 1656 in present-day New York and died at the young age of 24 years old in 1680 in present-day Quebec. When she was 4 years old she contracted small pox, which left a scar on her face. While she survived her family did not. At 19 years old she converted to Catholicism. Because of this her adoptive parents and neighbors persecuted her. So she left the village for a Christian settlement south of Montreal. Here Kateri was able to grow in her faith and love for Jesus. She was known for fasting often. And when she did eat she made her food bland and almost flavorless. But she never fasted from the Holy Mass, as she was known to beat the priest to the chapel every morning for Mass. "I will willingly abandon this miserable body to hunger and suffering," she once said, "provided that my soul have its ordinary nourishment." What a great model we have in St Kateri, especially in this culture that puts so much emphasis on physical beauty and appearance. St Kateri Tekakwitha, pray for us!
