**Fr Scott Says:** I caught the end of the MLB All-star game on TV a few days ago. One of the commentators spoke about how great it would be to change the rules for extra-innings, so as to speed the game along. Some rules have already been changed to speed the game up. But personally I feel all of these changes show how we as a culture are so self-absorbed that we cannot accept the world is bigger than ourselves. (It also proves we fail at sitting still.) We are so busy trying to modernize everything that we fail to see the beauty that already exists. One thing that fascinates me about baseball is about how old of a game it is. While it seems that a lot has changed over the years I believe that the all-stars of 100 years ago could still competitively play the all-stars of today, if not whip them. Baseball has a sense of timelessness to it, which I find beautiful. Boston still plays in a stadium 105 years old. Wrigley Field of Chicago isn't far behind. Perhaps I love baseball because it reminds me of true, unadulterated Christianity. Christianity, too, is timeless. And so is our worship. The prayers of the Mass from 1,000 years ago are just as effective and awesome as the prayers of today (if not more). Many of our temples across the globe outdate every baseball field and even many countries. And they are far more beautiful, too. That's because the beauty shown in our temples is Divine beauty. Why should we want to modernize what's worked so great for so long? God doesn't change according to the times. Rather, the times should change according to God. And the same goes for Baseball—in its purest form it can truly teach us the patience of God.
