Fr Scott Says: Friday is the feast day of St John Vianney (d.1859), the universal patron of priests. He was a priest in a rural parish in France. He is a fan favorite among seminarians because he supposedly failed at Latin in his studies. When he arrived at his parish in Ars, he found most people were ignorant of the faith and living sinful lives. He devoted his life to reconciling penitents as well as preaching against the blasphemies and sinful practices of his day. Now an international shrine and retreat house exists in Ars, drawing pilgrims from around the world. I plan to take a retreat there myself in October. St John Vianney also had a strong devotion to St Philomena as his little Wonder Worker. It is due to St John's devotion to St Philomena that she is as well known as she is today. St John also once penned a letter to a French priest in Mississippi. That letter is kept safe in our diocesan archives. Take a moment this Friday and pray for all parish priests (and for new ones) through the intercession of St John Vianney, their model and patron.

Indulgence Alert! Wednesday, August 2 is the day of the Portiuncula Indulgence, granted through the efforts of St Francis in the early 13th century. This plenary indulgence (full remittal of temporal punishment) can be gained once for yourself and once more for a poor soul in purgatory (that's two visits to your parish church). Simply visit any Catholic church, pray an Our Father and Creed as well as one extra prayer for our Holy Father. Also, within a reasonable amount of time make a worthy confession, receive Holy Communion worthily, and strive to avoid all attachment to sin. If you fail at any of the last three requirements, worry not because you will still have obtained a partial indulgence. But why not go for the gold?
