**Fr Scott Says:** “Raymund, what is to become of you?” These words came from young Raymund Kolbe’s mother one day when she had finally had enough of his mischievous acts. Raymund asked himself the same question, then went to his parish church and posed the question to the Blessed Mother. In his own words: “She appeared, holding in her hands two crowns, one white, one red. She asked if I would like to have them—one was for purity, the other for martyrdom. I said, ‘I choose both.’ She smiled and disappeared.” Raymund would go on to join the Franciscans and take the name Maximilian. He held onto his purity and virginity, traveling the world bringing many souls to Christ. In 1941, he died by lethal injection at Auschwitz. St Maximilian lived his life devoted to Jesus through Mary. And it began with his parents teaching him the faith and a deep love for Jesus through Mary. If it weren’t for that, he may have never posed that question to his Blessed Mother that day. Do you teach your children a love for their Blessed Mother in Heaven? On Tuesday we thank God for her place in Heaven, which assures us of ours. Mary is working hard to get us there. Are we teaching our children to listen, like St Maximilian’s parents taught him? Today, he is a patron saint of drug addicts and prisoners. St Maximilian Kolbe, pray for us!
