**Fr Scott Says:** Four years after proclaiming the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary a dogma of the Church, Pope Pius XII instituted the memorial of the Queenship of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Originally he placed it on May 31, but since the reform of the calendar we now celebrate it on Aug 22, the octave day following the Assumption. That's this Tuesday. Pope Pius XII was not creating a new title for Mary, though. This title dates back to at least the fourth century, when St Ephrem called Mary "queen". There's also the famous *Salve Regina* prayer, commonly known as "The Hail Holy Queen," which could date back as far as the 10th century. Calling Mary our Queen is also biblical, as Gabriel himself told Mary that her Son would receive the throne of David and rule forever. That makes her a queen, right? By no means does this make Mary equal to Jesus. Rather, it reaffirms her as a loving intercessor for us all. Thank her for this love by praying the "Hail, Holy Queen" this week!
