Fr Scott Says: When Peter confesses his belief in Jesus as the Son of God (Mt 16:16), Jesus responds, “Blessed are you... For flesh and blood has not revealed this to you, but my heavenly Father.” Peter was an uneducated fisherman. There’s no way he could have known this other than through divine inspiration. The same goes for the rest of the Apostles—they were most certainly divinely inspired. “For how otherwise could twelve uneducated men, who lived on lakes and rivers and wastelands, get the idea for such an immense enterprise?” asks St John Chrysostom (d.407). Throughout Jesus’ life they ran from trouble, begged Him to sit in the best seat in Heaven, and even denied Him as He hung on the Cross. Concerning this, St John Chrysostom continues, “How then account for the fact that these men... set forth to do battle with the whole world...? Did they perhaps say to themselves: ‘What is this? He could not save himself but he will protect us? He did not help himself when he was alive, but now that he is dead he will extend a helping hand to us? In his lifetime he brought no nation under his banner, but by uttering his name we will win over the whole world?’ Would it not be wholly irrational even to think such thoughts, much less to act upon them? It is evident, then, that if they had not seen him risen and had proof of his power, they would not have risked so much.” Therefore, the holy Catholic Church is *the* Church founded by Jesus Christ with His Apostles as its foundation holding it up. And it continues to this day in a continuous unbroken line of succession kept through her bishops and led by the Holy Father in Rome, the successor of Peter himself. It is not a medieval invention, but the work of God. And without it we cannot live.
