Fr Scott Says: I remember sitting at lunch a few years back with a friend and father of two. He told me of how his young son brought his phone up to him and said, "Hey dad, I need you to put an internet filter on my phone." First, the courage of that child is commendable. Secondly, it brings up a great point—are we keeping vigilant and teaching our youth the moral responsibility that comes with having cell phones, iPads, and other technology? We don't just give kids a driver's license. They have to first learn how to drive properly and safely. We need to be just as careful with technology in the palms of our hands and in our rooms with closed doors. Cinemax did not cut out pornography because of a moral conscience. They cut it out because pornography is now available upon demand. Kids no longer have to sneak out of their room late at night to watch tv without the sound on. They just have to unlock their phones. The Venerable Archbishop Fulton Sheen once said, "When a child is given to his parents, a crown is made for that child in Heaven, and woe to the parents who raise a child without consciousness of that eternal crown!" That crown is getting harder and harder to obtain these days. But what is more important in the end—social acceptance or the eternal crown? Saint John Paul II, pray for us!
