Fr Scott Says: All Souls Day indulgences—make a plan! You have two chances to apply indulgences to the Poor Souls of Purgatory. To obtain a plenary indulgence for a poor soul on November 2, complete the following: (1) make a good confession within a week before or after Nov. 2, (2) be free from all attachment to sin, even venial sin, (3) visit a church to pray for the faithful departed and pray one “Our Father” and the “Creed” in addition to one “Our Father” and one “Hail Mary” for the Pope’s monthly intentions, and finally (4) receive Holy Communion on the same day or soon after. OR to obtain a plenary indulgence sometime between Nov. 1-7, do the same except in place of the visit to a church (#3), visit a cemetery and pray any prayer for the dead along with the prayers for the Pope’s monthly intentions. A plenary indulgence completely frees a soul of any required penance for past sins. That means a soul is immediately released from Purgatory and welcomed into Heaven to pray for you! If you only partially complete what is prescribed above, a partial indulgence is obtained.
