Fr Scott Says: On Wednesday we heard the Beatitudes proclaimed for the Gospel reading. One of them struck me recently— "Blessed are the clean of heart, for they will see God." Other translations read "Blessed are the *pure* of heart". It is the pure who literally *see* God. We believe so much more quickly in things that we can see with our own eyes. We struggle believing in God at times because we can't always see Him. Yet, Jesus tells us if we keep a pure and clean heart, we *will* see God. Our world talks about purity as a lacking, because purity involves chastity. And the world sees chastity as a lacking of something, instead of fulfilment. Do we teach our youth (and even ourselves) that chastity is a fulfilling practice as opposed to a lacking? Purity is fulfilling because it frees us to see God and love Him with our *whole* mind, heart, and soul. Don't we want to see God? Then outside of marriage we should strive to embrace purity and chastity in speech, thought, and action. And within marriage, strive to find the pure meaning of the marital act as an action of love and unity, not letting lust rule our hearts. And, as always, let us run to the confessional whenever we fall, trusting in the merciful love of Jesus Christ our Savior. "Blessed are the pure of heart, for they will see God."
